**RESOLVE, in Favor of E. Maude Dionne, of Skowhegan.**

**E. Maude Dionne; retirement benefit granted. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, granted to E. Maude Dionne of Skowhegan, a retirement benefit of \$25 per month during her lifetime, to be paid from the funds of the Maine state retirement system. Such retirement benefit shall be retroactive to January 1, 1955. Such retirement allowance shall not be payable until E. Maude Dionne has paid to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$650 which has been refunded to Mrs. Dionne by the system.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

J. Thomas Dionne was employed by the State Highway Commission for 5 years and Employment Security Commission for 5 years. Died September 30, 1946. His widow receives no retirement benefits but has only been paid back the contributions Mr. Dionne had made.
