AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Examination of Industrial Banks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 59, § 208, amended. Section 208 of chapter 59 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

‘The expenses of the Banking Department necessarily incurred in the examination of industrial banks shall be chargeable to such institutions under the provisions of section 2, and they shall be subject to the same semiannual assessments as provided in section 2, on the same basis as applies to loan and building associations.’
