**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Richmond, Maine, Camp Grounds of the Church
of the Nazarene.**

Maine Nazarene Campgrounds Incorporated; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$1,394.62 to be paid to the Maine Nazarene Campgrounds Incorporated of Richmond, as a full and final settlement for claim against the State for damage done to the property of The Richmond, Maine, Camp Grounds of the Church of the Nazarene in April, 1954, by escapees from the State School for Boys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In April, 1954, several boys escaped from the State School for Boys and broke into the Richmond, Maine, Camp Grounds of the Church of the Nazarene. Practically every building on the grounds was damaged to a greater, or lesser, extent. Attached is itemized list of repairs and materials.
