RESOLVE, to Reimburse Horace Hinkley of Richmond for Damages Done by Parolees.

Horace Hinkley; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$750 to be paid to Horace Hinkley, of Richmond, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1949 club coupe valued at \$750. The car was a total loss.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Hinkley's car was stolen on October 9, 1954 at Unity. Paul Phinney was a parolee. Car was valued at \$750 and was a total loss.
