RESOLVE, Reappropriating Road Resolve Funds in Town of Carmel.

Town of Carmel; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of Carmel by the 95th legislature for aid in installing a culvert for the bridge over Harvey stream on the so-called Fuller Road, be and hereby is reappropriated to be expended during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 to aid in building Five Bridge in said Carmel.

The need to build Five Bridge is great and the reappropriation of funds not used is necessary.
