**AN ACT Relating to Weir Fishing in Penobscot Bay and River for Atlantic Sea
Run Salmon.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 30, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 30 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

'Salmon may also be taken by weirs between the 1st day of April and the 15th day of July, both days inclusive, on Penobscot Bay and the Penobscot River south of the Waldo-Hancock Bridge and east of the Bucksport-Verona Bridge.'
