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**RESOLVE, Relating to the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge.**

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**Repayment of transfer. Resolved:** That the treasurer of the state is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to the credit of the general highway fund from the operating fund of the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge the sum of \$75,000, which was advanced in 1943 for emergency repairs and strengthening of the bridge.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

In 1943, unusual storm damage necessitated emergency repair to, and strengthening of, the bridge for which there were no available funds. The governor and council authorized a transfer of \$75,000 from the general highway fund to take care of this emergency. The operating fund has accumulated sufficient funds to repay this transfer but legislative authority is needed.
