AN ACT Relating to Filing of Nomination Papers in Municipal Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 91, § 54, amended. The first sentence of section 54 of chapter 91 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Certificates of nomination shall be filed with the town clerk of said town at least 8 days previous to the day of election and nomination papers shall be so filed at least 6 days previous to the day of election **unless the town shall by vote establish a different filing date.**'
