STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT in Increase the Salaries of the Judge and the Recorder of the Western Washington Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1921, c. 113, § 15, amended. The 1st sentence of section 15 of chapter 113 of the private and special laws of 1921, as amended by chapter 67 of the private and special laws of 1947 and by chapter 147 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive as compensation a salary of \$7,800 \$2,100 a year; and the recorder shall receive a salary of \$750 \$900 a year, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Washington.'
