STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Calais Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1883, c. 325, § 23, amended. The 4th sentence of section 23 of chapter 325 of the private and special laws of 1883, as amended by chapter 106 of the private and special laws of 1947 and by chapter 148 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The compensation of the judge in full for all services shall be ~~\$1,800~~ **\$2,100** per year, payable quarterly from the treasury of the county of Washington.'
