STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide Training to Organized Fire Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. R. S., c. 41, § 11-A, additional. Chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 11-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 11-A. Traning for organized fire companies. The State Board of Education is authorized and empowered to provide training to organized fire companies and to provide mobile training equipment and accessories.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$10,000 to purchase necessary equipment, the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957, to carry out the provisions of this act.
