**AN ACT to Provide Training to Organized Fire Companies.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 41, § 11-A, additional.** Chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 11-A, to read as follows :

**'Sec. 11-A. Training for organized fire companies. The State Board of Education is authorized and empowered to provide training to organized fire companies and to provide mobile training equipment and accessories.'**

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$10,000 to purchase necessary equipment, the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957, to carry out the provisions of this act.
