AN ACT Relating to Fees of Deputy Sheriffs in Attendance at Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub § XV, amended. Subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘XV. Every deputy sheriff and court messenger, while in attendance upon the supreme judicial court or the superior court in their several counties, shall receive for said attendance and service \$10 a day **while the court is in session to run continuously from the convening of the court until adjournment**, plus their necessary travel at 20c a mile from their place of abode for each day’s attendance.’
