RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Rattlesnake (Pequawket) Pond, Oxford County.

Fishing in Rattlesnake (Pequawket) Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to remove all size and bag limits on white perch and pickerel in Rattlesnake (Pequawket) Pond, in the county of Oxford. The open season to conform with the general law, ice fishing and open water fishing seasons in all waters.
