AN ACT Relating to Rental for Brewer Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 88, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 88 of the private and special laws of 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows: :

'Sec. 6. Location of court; expense of court; rental. Said court shall be held at such place as the city of Brewer shall provide and said city shall have power and it shall be its duty to raise money to provide a proper place for said court and its officers and suitably furnish, warm and light the said court room, **for which there shall be paid from the county of Penobscot, as rental, the sum of \$500, annually, in quarterly payments.** All other expenses of said court shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
