COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 93, L. D. 223, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Installations within Highway
Limits."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th and 7th lines the underlined words "edge of the paved portion." and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'near edge of the paved portion of Highways (not including shoulders) having more than 2 travel lanes, having a total paved portion in excess of 24 feet in width.'

Further amend said Bill by changing the period at the end thereof to a comma and adding the following underlined words, 'and the 20-foot limitation shall not apply to the installations or other property devoted to public use of any public utility or district or to underground pipe lines, or to the installations or other property in existence prior to the effective date of this act.'

Reported by the Committee on Highways.

Read and adopted in the Senate April 5, 1955.
