RESOLVE, in Favor of Fred Smith, of Newport.

Fred Smith; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$330.89 from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, to be paid to Fred Smith, of Newport, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident happened December 25, 1953 at 4:30 P.M. in the town of Newport, and was investigated by Game Warden Stanley B. Richardson. Mr. Smith's car was damaged to the extent of \$330.89.
