AN ACT Relating to Construction of Entrances to Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 23, § 36, amended. The third sentence of section 36 is hereby amended to read as follows :

'No permit shall be required for any ~~existing~~ driveway, entrance or approach **existing on August 20, 1951** unless the grade or location, **or change in degree or kind of use** of the same is changed, but if any driveway, entrance or approach is changed in location or **grade or change in degree or kind of use** or improved, a permit shall be required.'
