STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Black Bass.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37, § 44, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 44 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'II. There shall be an open season for black bass in lakes and ponds from June 21st to September 30th; in rivers above tidewater from June 21st to September 15th; in brooks and streams from June 21st to August 15th. Provided, however, that 3 black bass per day on single-hooked artificial lures only may be taken by fly fishing in any + day from June 1st to June 20th and no person shall have in his possession at any 1 time more than 3 black bass during this period. There shall be a closed season for bass in the inland waters of Cumberland county from October 1st to June 20th, both days inclusive.'
