RESOLVE, Regulating White Perch Fishing in Cochnewagon Pond.

Cochnewagon Pond; fishing for white perch regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation providing that there shall be no bag limit or size on white perch taken in Cochnewagon Pond in the town of Monmouth, county of Kennebec.
