STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Dependents of Deceased Policemen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 64, § 6, sub-§ VIII, amended. Subsection VIII of section 6 of chapter 64 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'If a member of the retirement system who is a member of a police department shall die as a result of injury received in line of duty, his widow, or, if none, his minor child or children shall receive an annual sum equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the average final compensation of such member at the time of his death. Such annual sum shall be paid to the widow until she dies or remarries or to a child or children until they die or reach the age of 18 years.'
