STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as last amended by chapter 160 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder; clerk hire. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all services, of \$2,000 \$2,300 per annum to be paid him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of \$1,200 \$1,400 per annum, payable monthly, and such additional amount for clerk hire as may be authorized by the county commissioners.'
