## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the Bangor Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 211, amended. The 1st sentence of the last paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 9" of chapter 89 of the private and special laws of 1953, which amended chapter 211 of the private and special laws of 1895, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The salaries of the judge and recorder thereof, which are hereby fixed at \$3,500 \$3,800 and \$3,000 \$3,300, respectively, to be paid monthly, with all other expenses of said court, shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
