**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Roscoe Morse of Rockland for Damage by Escaped
Prisoner of State Prison.**

Rosco Morse; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$300 to be paid to Roscoe Morse, of Rockland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1953 Willys, by another car the operator of which was an escaped prisoner of the Maine State Prison.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Accident occurred on January 22, 1955 at Rockland. The Willys owned by Mr. Morse was parked at the curb on Main Street, the other vehicle being operated by an escaped prisoner from the State Prison in Thomaston, and being pursued by the Rockland Police Department did not make the corner at Park and Main Streets and crashed into the car.
