**RESOLVE, to Construct Road from Harris Hill to East Poland,  
Androscoggin County.**

---

**Road from Harris Hill to East Poland, construction; appropriation. Resolved:** That there be and hereby is appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$33,000 to construct the road leading from Harris Hill to East Poland, Androscoggin County, a distance of about 2.2 miles; such construction to be under the supervision of the State Highway Commission.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

This road is a designated State Aid highway. It is a mail route and is traveled by school buses. It is in poor condition.
