IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Designating Part of Route No. 9 as State Highway.

State Highway Number 9, designated. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be and hereby is authorized and directed to designate that part of Route No. 9 commencing at the junction of Route No. 137 in Freedom, Waldo County, and extending to the junction of Route No. 1 in Hampden, Penobscot County, as a State highway.
