IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Construct Certain Road in Gardiner.

State Aid highway construction; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$50,000 to construct highway in the City of Gardiner, beginning at the junction of Bridge Street and Main Avenues (Routes No. 24, No. 27 and No. 201) and extending southerly along Main Avenue to Depot Square; said construction to be under the supervision of the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This highway is part of the through route from Augusta to Gardiner to the coast. It is very heavily traveled, and is in poor condition.
