**RESOLVE, Constructing Part of Route No. 5 in York County.**

---

**Route No. 5, York County, reconstructed. Resolved:** That the State Highway Commission be and hereby is authorized and directed to reconstruct Route No. 5, York County, for about 5 miles, beginning at the junction of Routes No. 202, No. 4 and No. 5 at Lyman and extending along Route No. 5 to the Iron Bridge, so called, across the Saco River.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

This road is on the direct route from Old Orchard to Quebec and is very heavily traveled.
