STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Repealing Prohibition to Hunt Muskrats in Lake Alamoosook and Dead River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ I, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed as follows:

'No muskrats shall be hunted or trapped in Lake Alamoosook and Dead River and its tributaries in the town of Orland situated in Hancock county.'
