RESOLVE, Granting Master Plumber's License to Ernest L. Douglass of Bangor.

Ernest L. Douglass granted master plumber's license. Resolved: That the Plumbers' Examining Board be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to license Ernest L. Douglass of Bangor as a master plumber without examination and on payment of a fee of \$15.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Douglass has been in the plumbing business in Bangor since 1912. Up until the passage of the State law relating to plumbers' licenses he had a Master Plumber's license, as issued by the City of Bangor. He became Superintendent of Bangor's largest plumbing firm and for the past 25 years has been President of C. H. Babb & Company and manager of the Plumbing Division of that Company.

It was his belief that his office staff in filing under the "grandfather clause" would file such application as would secure for him a Master Plumber's license and he continued to believe that until about 2 years ago when he learned that his name was not among those filed. It is his belief that his long years of experience and his prior possession of a plumber's license justifies the action of the Board in now issuing to him a master plumber's license.
