IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1915, c. 34, § 1, amended. The 1st sentence of section 1 of chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1915, as last amended by chapter 55 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of the Eastport municipal court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,800, payable quarterly, from the county treasury of the county of Washington, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1915, c. 34, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1915, as last amended by chapter 65 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 2. Salary of recorder, when paid; fees.** The recorder of the Eastport municipal court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of ~~\$200~~ \$250, payable quarterly, from the county treasury of the county of Washington, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October. All fees collected by him shall be paid over to the county treasurer.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1955.
