STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Racoons in Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ VII, amended. Subsection VII of section 113 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'VII. It shall be lawful to hunt and kill racoons in Waldo county and on the islands of North Haven and Vinalhaven, in the county of Knox, at any time except on Sunday and at night. Night shall be the period from ½ hour after sunset until ½ hour before sunrise of the following morning; except that it shall be lawful to hunt racoons during the open season as provided in subsection IV.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 113 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'The provisions of this subsection as they apply to racoons shall not apply to Waldo county.'
