AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of Trial Justices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 110, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 110 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'After the effective date of his act, no trial justice shall be appointed to hold court within a radius of 10 miles of any municipal court.'
