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**City of Ellsworth; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$562.45 to be paid to the city of Ellsworth to reimburse it for aid given to Lester G. Foss and family, state paupers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lester Foss and family lived in Wesley for 5 years and 2 months. They then moved to Ellsworth for one year. Ellsworth furnished them with supplies in the amount of \$562.45. Ellsworth brought suit against the town of Wesley for this amount and lost the case.
