RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Rangeley River, Franklin County.

Rangeley river; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Rangeley river, Rangeley Twp., Franklin county, to fly fishing only from dam at outlet of Rangeley lake to its confluence with Cusuptic lake until September 30, with a daily limit of one fish.
