**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Loon Island to
Mrs. Anna Fowler and Julius Peterson.**

Forest Commissioner; authorization to convey Loon Island. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey to Mrs. Anna Fowler and Julius Peterson, of South Portland, the interest of the State in Loon Island in Forest Lake, town of Gray, county of Cumberland, for the sum of \$75.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

All Islands in great ponds not previously sold by the State prior to 1913 shall remain as State property for public use. At last session of Legislature several bills were turned down because of this law.

The family of Julius Peterson and Mrs. Fowler have occupied this property since 1912 and have paid taxes to the town of Gray for 30 years. They are now requesting legal title or deed to the above property under the names of Mrs. Anna Fowler and Julius Peterson.
