AN ACT Relating to Military Leave Credits under State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section one of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding to subsection VI, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No such credits shall be allowed to count toward a state retirement benefit beyond the period of first enlistment or induction into the said armed forces unless the individual involved is compelled to continue service under some mandatory provision of the Selective Service Act.'
