IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Clarence Ramdell of Lubec.

Clarence Ramdell; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Clarence Ramdell, of Lubec, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Ramdell is 62 years of age and mentally retarded. He has no relatives and is unable to work, therefore he has no income.
