STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, for State Pension for Welma K. O'Dell of Hallowell.

Welma K. O'Dell; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Welma K. O'Dell, of Hallowell, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. O'Dell was injured on February 7, 1954 while working as an attendant in employ of Augusta State Hospital. She was awarded compensation for total disability from February 7, 1954 to April 3, 1954. Partial compensation from April 5 to July 29 at which time compensation ended. She is not a member of State Retirement System.
