AN ACT Relating to Local Option for Sale of Malt Liquor in Part-time Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting before the 3rd paragraph from the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'If a majority of the votes cast in any municipality in answer to question IX is in the affirmative, the ballots for that municipality at the next biennial general election shall carry such question without petition.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting before the 2nd paragraph from the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'If a majority of the votes cast in any municipality in answer to question IX is in the negative, the ballots for that municipality at the next biennial general election shall carry such question only after the petition required by this section.'
