STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

An Act Relating to Taking of Tom Cods in Gouldsboro and Steuben.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Taking of tom cods in Gouldsboro and Steuben. It shall be lawful to fish for or take any tom cods between October 1st and May 1st each year in the following waters of Hancock and Washington Counties: In all the waters of Whitten Parritt Stream in the Town of Gouldsboro, Hancock County, in the waters of Tunk Stream and in all waters tributary to or which empty into Steuben Bay and Joys Bay above the Lobster Island Narrows, so called, at Rogers Point in the Town of Steuben, Washington County.
