RESOLVE, Authorizing Commissioner of Institutional Service to Grant Pole Line Easements on the Property of the State of Maine in Bangor.

Commissioner of Institutional Service authorized to convey certain pole line easements. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Institutional Service, with the approval of the Governor and Council be, and hereby is, authorized to grant to Bangor Hydro-Electric Company such easements as may be mutually agreed upon, on terms that may be mutually agreed upon, covering the location of electric lines on the property of the State of Maine in Bangor lying northerly of Mount Hope Avenue, westerly of the Hogan Road, southerly of land now or formerly owned by Hugh Davis and easterly of land now or formerly owned by Albin Rudnicki.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to the construction of part of Interstate Highway 95 in the vicinity of the Hogan Road at Bangor it has become necessary for Bangor Hydro-Electric Company to relocate a portion of its existing transmission lines from land now or formerly owned by Hugh Davis of Bangor to land at Bangor now owned by the State of Maine as shown on plans now filed at the office of the State Highway Commission.
