AN ACT Eliminating Necessity for Sheriff's Apartment in Jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 178, amended. Section 178 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

'It is not necessary for the county commissioners to provide a house near the jail or apartment in the jail for the sheriff or jailer, if such house or apartment is not now in existence and in use by the sheriff or jailer, and a new jail may be built without provision for such apartment.'
