RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for the Renovation of Corthell Hall, First and Third Floors, at Gorham State Teachers' College.

Gorham State Teachers' College; appropriation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$19,000 in favor of Gorham State Teachers' College to renovate room 6, room 4, the main office and the former geology laboratory on the first floor, and to renovate portions of the third floor, Corthell Hall. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This project is to provide needed space for the expansion of office facilities and to provide additional classroom space and practice rooms for the Music Education Department.
