STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for a Parking Space Adjacent to the Industrial Arts Building at Gorham State Teachers' College.

Gorham State Teachers' College; appropriation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$23,400 in favor of Gorham State Teachers' College to construct a parking area of 50,264 square feet adjacent to the Industrial Arts Building. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This parking area will provide adequate parking space for industrial arts students and for overflow parking for the entire college.
