CHAPTER XC.

AN ACT to incorporate the Master, Wardens and Members of Amity Lodge.

SECT. 1. **BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of
Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Jonas
Wheeler, Frederick Jacobs, and Joseph W. Thorn-
dike, and their associates and successors, be, and they
hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the
name of the master, wardens and members of Amity
Lodge; with power to sue and be sued; to have a
common seal, and to change the same; to make any
by-laws for the management of their affairs, not repug-
nant to the laws of this State, nor to ancient masonic
usages; to take and hold for charitable and benevo-
lent uses, any real estate, to the value of three thou-
sand dollars, and any personal estate to the value of
five thousand dollars; and to give and grant, or bar-
gain and sell the same; and with all the privileges
usually granted to other societies, instituted for pur-
poses of charity and beneficence.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the first meet-
ing of said corporation, shall be holden at such time
and place, and be notified in such manner, as the ma-
jority of the persons herein named may direct.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That the powers
granted by this act, may be enlarged, restrained, or re-
pealed, at the pleasure of the Legislature.
