## CHAPTER CL.

AN ACT to apportion and assess on this State a Tax of Forty Thousand, Three Fundred and Forty-Three Dollars and Twenty-Seven Cents.

Sect. 1. We it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That each town, plantation or other place hereinafter named, within this State, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they stand respectively charged in the following Schedule, viz :
