In Council, May 9, 1821.

Messrs. Wood and LANE, the Committee to whom was referred the Statement and Report of the Committee of the Legislature appointed by a Resolve of 22d March, 1821, to examine certain accounts, &c. Reported, that the several sums are accurately cast, and there is justly due and ought now to be paid for Pauper Accounts, to the several corporations named in said Statement, seven thousand nine hundred and forty-nine dollars and fifty-two cents; and that the Governor be advised to draw his warrant on the Treasury for said sum.

Which REPORT was accepted, by the Governor approved, and the warrant drawn accordingly,
