with all the privileges usually granted to other societies instituted for the purposes of charity and beneficence.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the first meeting of said corporation shall be holden at such time and place, and be notified in such manner, as the majority of the persons herein named may direct.

First meeting.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That the powers, granted by this act, may be enlarged, restrained or repealed, at the pleasure of the Legislature.

CHAPTER CLXXIV.

AN ACT additional to "An Act to incorporate the Portland Steam Boat Navigation Company."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the limitations, contained in the proviso of the first section of an act to incorporate the Portland Steam Boat Navigation Company, requiring the said corporation to carry the conditions of the said act into operation by the last day of May next, be extended six months from and after the last day of May next.

Extension of time allowed to company to commence operations.

CHAPTER CLXXV.

AN ACT to set off part of lot numbered nine, in the tenth range, from the town of Canton, and annex the same to the town of Jay.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That so much of the lot of land numbered nine, in the tenth range, in the town of Canton, as lies east of the west side of the town road, leading through said lot of land, is hereby set off from the town of Canton, and annexed to the town of Jay: *Provided*, That the proprietor of said land shall be holden to pay all assessments, assessed on said land, and remaining unpaid, prior to the passing of this act.
