CHAPTER CCCXX.

AN ACT to authorize the Selectmen of Gardiner to appoint an additional number of Engine-men.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Selectmen of the town of Gardiselectmen of ner, in the county of Kennebec, for the time Gardiner authorized to appoint being, be, and they hereby are authorized, in a certain number manner by law provided, for the appointment of engine-men, to appoint for the Engine in said town, called the Hydraulion, a number of enginemen, not to exceed thirty-two.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That the who are to be engine-men so appointed, shall be subject to all same duties as the duties and liabilities, and shall be entitled to inen. all the privileges and exemptions of engine-men appointed in manner by law provided.
